## WHAT IS A PLENARY INDULGENCE?

The Holy Father declares that the gift of indulgences *"allows us to discover how limitless God's mercy is...precisely because it is intended to express the fullness of God's forgiveness, which knows no limits."* [Spes non confundit, 23]. **Plenary Indulgences are, therefore, a Jubilee grace**.

His Excellency Bishop Daniel Miehm has issued a **Jubilee Year Indulgence Decree** for the Diocese of Peterborough [<u>READ DECREE</u>]. The Decree states that four churches throughout the diocese may be visited by the faithful to fulfill the requirements for the indulgence: **St. Michael the Archangel** in Cobourg; **Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary** in Lindsay; **St. Patrick's** in Kearney; and principle among them, the **Cathedral of St. Peter-in-Chains** in Peterborough. May this Holy Year be a source of hope, rich in spiritual fruit for all the situations that are dear to us, especially for local and global situations in which hope seems to succumb in the face of so much evil and suffering in the world.
